#### Assessment Policy:

- (i) It is mandatory to obtain **40% marks (Grade C2), IN EACH SUBJECT** individually to pass. This applies to every assessment (Periodic Test, Subject Enrichment Activity, Test Series etc.) conducted throughout the Academic Session.
- (ii) **Appearing in all Assessments is mandatory** for appearing in the CBSE Board Exam. In case your ward has a genuine problem or is suffering from any contagious disease and is likely to be absent for any periodic assessment/ half yearly, an application along with medical certificate must be submitted before the day of exam. The case will be reviewed by the Principal on an individual basis.
- (iii) The student must have minimum **80% attendance** in the Academic Session, failing which he/she will not be allowed to appear in the CBSE Board Exam.
- (iv) No Retest will be conducted if the student is on leave on exam day.
