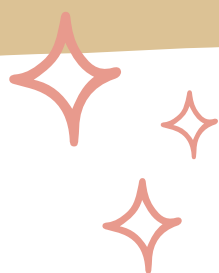

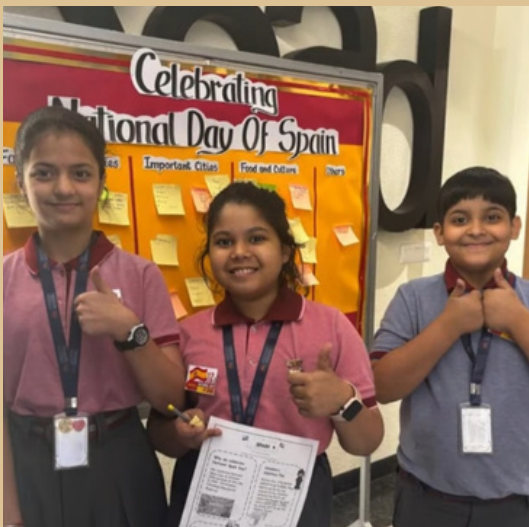
# Onam Celebration

Sparkle Sustainably: Embracing a Green, Cracker-Free Diwali!

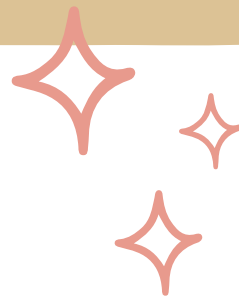

We deeply value the dedication of our parents in making these activities meaningful. Together, we nurture a supportive community that encourages academic success, creativity, and social responsibility.



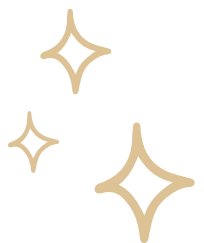
## Food Fest

# Gracious Grey

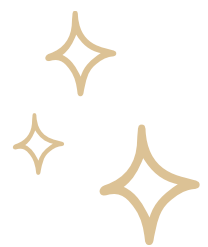

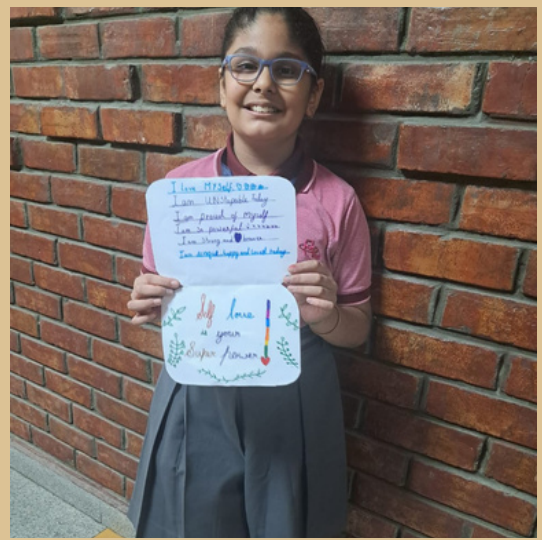
# Safe & Unsafe Touch ✨

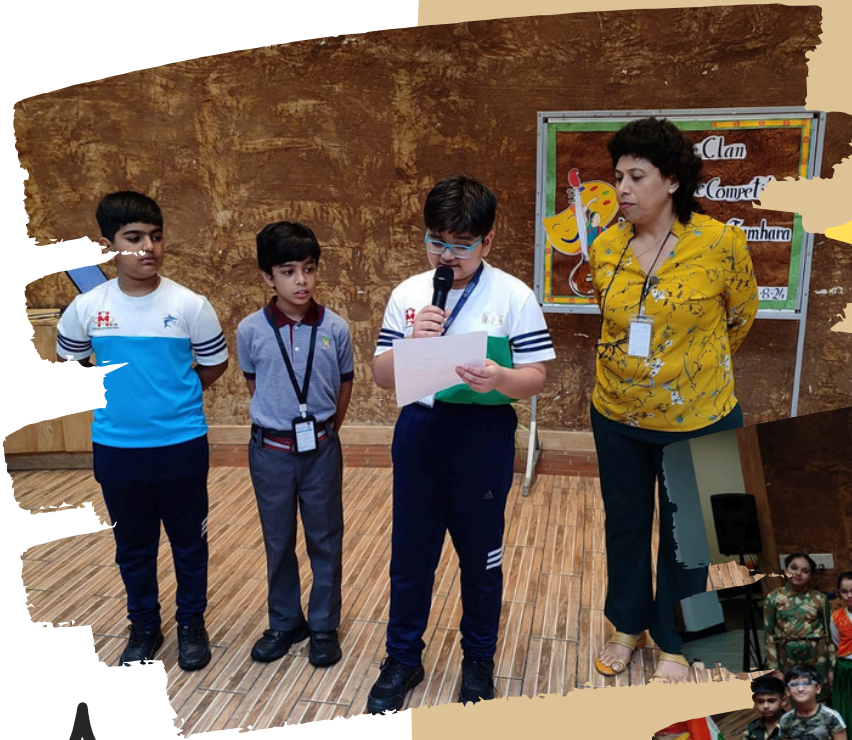
# Mental Health Awareness ✨

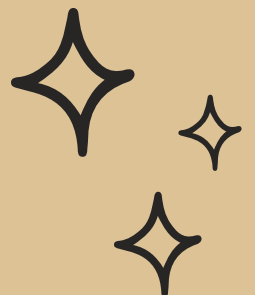




## Inter Clan Solo Dance Competition

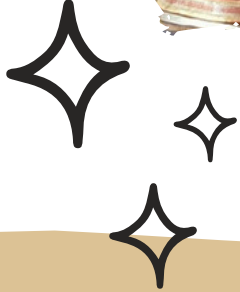

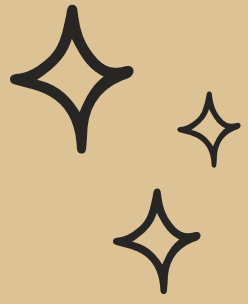




## Inter Clan Group Dance Competition

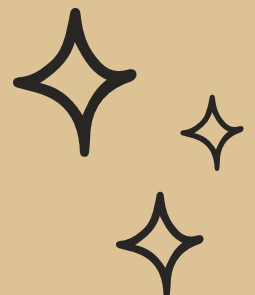




# Inter Clan English Declamation Competition

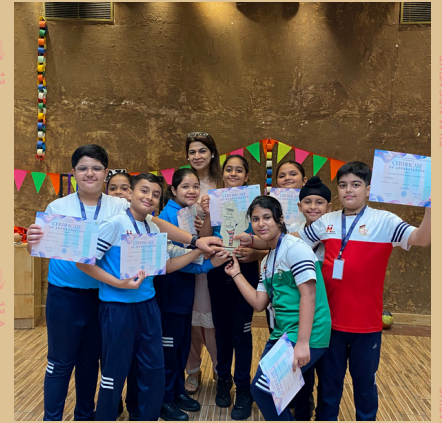
## ULLAS Competition

Congratulations to our talented students for this well-deserved recognition! We wish them continued success in their artistic pursuits and beyond.



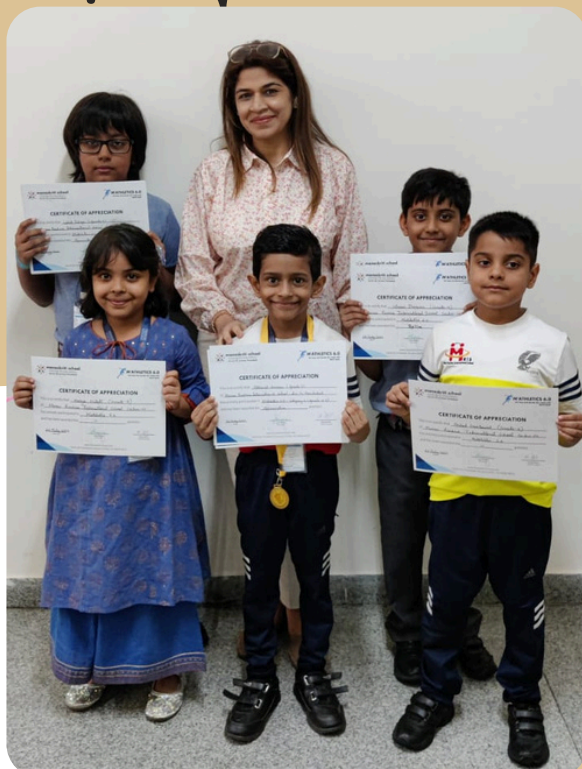
## Matheletics 6.0

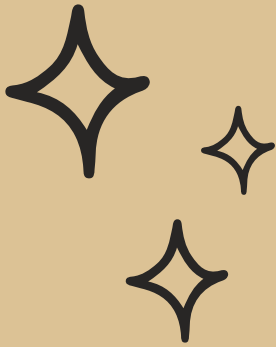

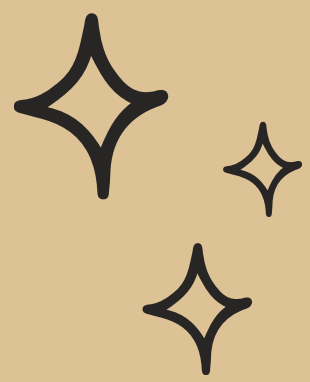

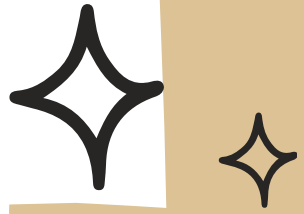
